## List of things needed for the Funeral Ceremony at home or at crematorium.

### To be prepared at home.

- Gee in small bowel (1 tablespoons).
- 3 spoons of Panchamrut (Mixed with Ghee, honey, yogurt, milk and sugar)
- Little Rice in a bowel.
- Raw Kichadi tied in white handkerchief (Mixed with MUG & Rice).
- 4 Pinds like small ladu ( made of Rice flour and milk)
- 2 Tulsi patra (leaves) 3 .

### Things to buy

- White cloth 2 ½ yard (if you want to put Shawl man or sari for ladies then no need of white cloth,)
- White cloth 1 ½ yard (this is to put under the coffin)
- Ganga jal.
- Chandan, Abil, Gulal and Kanku.
- ½ lbs of Tal (Sesame seeds) and ½ lbs Jav (barley).
- 4 Coconuts.
- Mango pulp ( if family wishes). 2 Spoons only
- Sandal wood pieces.
- Sandalwood garland
- Flower Garland (if family wishes).
- Flowers Patel's.
- 5 Flowers.
- Kanthi (if required).
- Punchdatu
- Janoi (if man)
- One packet of Agarmati (Incense)

# <u>Preparation at Home. Please keep this ready, day before and check list everything.</u>

- **Put in each bowl** (vatki steel or plastic ) gangajal, water, rice, Chandan, Abil, Gulal and Kanku, Panchamrut , Tal ( Sesame seeds) Jav (barley).
- Put each bowel in a one or two plate.
- Mix little Kanku with water for Chandlow for man and a married woman,
- For a widow mix chnadan with water for chandlow.
- Gangajal ( put one tulsi leave).
- In one tray bowel of water and spoon.
- Decide in advance who will do the ceremony.
- Two Steel spoons small One for Gangajal+ tulsi Vatki and one for Punchamrut.

### Things to be taken to the Crematorium

- Decide in advance which family member will carry the coffin in side.
- Divo with ghee
- 3 flowers
- One Agarbati (Incense) NOT a BOX
- Matchbox.
- Donation box if the family wants to donate money to charity.(or white handkerchief) 10% of the collection must be send to Gau (cow) Seva
- Siva Picture (if not at the Crematorium). In Leicester there is Sive picture in all crematorium.
- Decide in advance who will do the speeches.
- Decide who will go for the witness.
- Decide who will come to press the button
- Decide who will say Jai shree Krishna
- Finally decide who will stand in a que for jai shree Krishna.

#### If the ceremony (VIDHI) to be done at home or the Crematorium.

- The body must be put in such a way that head is towards North and the feet towards south.
- Photograph of the deceased's Photo.
- Diva (Dipak) put on the right side of the body.
- Put some grain near Diva.
- Decide who is going to do ceremony (Vidghi) ( Pind etc)
